Class 1. BE90 Dressage Test. Showjumping x Cross Country – 75-85cms

Class 2. BE100 Dressage Test. Showjumping x Cross Country – 85-95cms

Dressage will be indoors and set to commence approx 0900hrs

Jumping will be on an outdoor all weather surface. It will be a combination of showjumps followed by portable cross country fences.

Entries. Entry fee is £20(Inc VAT) and accepted on a first booked and paid basis. To be submitted by post with cheques made payable to Crumleigh Heath Ltd. The last entry will be the Monday before the event. Early entry advisable.

Tack and dress to BD/BE rules (whip allowed in dressage and a reader if required)

Body protectors are recommended to be worn for the jumping phase.

After the dressage there will be 20 mins allowed before proceeding to the jumping section for change of tack etc. An optimum time will be set for the jumping phase and the winner will be the person with the lowest accumulated penalty score.

The organisers reserve the right to eliminate any competitor who, in the judge's opinion, is not capable of riding the course, or who uses bad language or abusive behaviour or mistreats their horse/pony.
